Paying the fees

Consult the **processing fees** section of our Web site at www.chile.gc.ca or the *Guide for Skilled Worker Applicants* to calculate your fees.

All fees related to Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) services offered by the Embassy of Canada in Santiago must be paid in cash (Chilean pesos), at any Scotia Bank branch to the Canadian Embassy account.

The receipt from Scotia Bank must clearly show:

- the name(s) and surname(s) of the applicant(s);
- the bank seal (stamp);
- the account number of the Canadian embassy in Santiago; and,
- the amount paid.

The Canadian Embassy's bank account number is **97-00051-29** and the deposit must be made out to the *Embajada de Canadá*.

Note: The original receipt from the bank **must** be attached to the application. If you require a copy for your records, make your own copy prior to submission of the application at the Immigration Section of the Canadian Embassy.
