Paying the fees

Consult the Instruction guide or the Fees section of our Web site to calculate your fees.

For payment in Canadian dollars:

Bank draft or bank-issued cheque to pay the full immigration processing fee, in Canadian dollars. Because exchange rates vary, fees may be paid by bank draft, in Canadian dollars, drawn on a bank in Canada, and which will clear there. Make the draft payable to “The Receiver General for Canada”. Write your name and address on the back.

Make sure that you have sent the correct type of bank draft; otherwise, your application will be returned to you.

For payment in Rands:

Fees quoted in Rands are established monthly and will vary due to fluctuating exchange rates. You should verify the fees for the month you intend to submit your application. Our Web site at www.dfait-maeci.gc.ca/southafrica/ always shows the current fees.

Payment must be made by bank issued cheque. Fees must be submitted in the exact amount. Please note that neither personal cheques nor credit cards are accepted. Other currencies, such as U.S. dollars are also not accepted. **Do not send cash in the mail.**
