Appendix A - Bucharest

Paying the fees

Consult the Instruction guide or the Fees section of our [Web site](#) to calculate your fees.

All countries

In Canadian Dollars by certified instrument (bank draft, certified cheque, or money order)

You may pay by bank draft, certified cheque or international money order in Canadian Dollars, payable to the "*Receiver General for Canada*" and collectable at a Canadian banking institution. Write your name and address on the back or in the space for notes on the certified instrument. Make sure that you have sent the correct amount using the correct type of certified instrument as described; otherwise, it will be returned to you and your application delayed.

Note: Certified cheques must not be older than three months when received by the Bucharest office.

In Euro by making a payment by direct deposit at a bank authorized to take this type of payment

Current fees in Euros are available on the Embassy's web site: www.canadainternational.gc.ca/romania-roumanie/.

Romania

You can pay the processing fees in Euros (EUR) at a branch of Banca Transilvania in Romania. The original receipt "Visa Link" and the bank teller's receipt must be submitted with the application form and other documents required.

Bulgaria

You can pay the processing fees in Euros (EUR) at a branch of Union Bank in Bulgaria. The original receipt "Cash Deposit" issued by the bank must be submitted with the application form and other documents required.

Moldova

Banking arrangements by direct deposit are not available in Moldova. Residents of Moldova may pay the processing fees by using a certified instrument in Canadian dollars or by direct deposit in Euros (EUR) at a branch of Banca Transilvania in Romania.
