### Public policy: Open work permits for Hong Kong recent graduates

As a Hong Kong recent graduate, you may be eligible to apply for an open work permit under a <u>temporary public policy for Hong Kong residents</u>.

The open work permit is valid for **up to 3 years**.

## Who can apply

To be eligible, you must:

- hold a valid passport issued by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) or the United Kingdom to a British National Overseas (BNO)
  - The work permit will be issued for up to 3 years from the date of approval or until your passport expires, whichever comes first. For example, if your passport is valid for 6 months, then you will be issued an open work permit for 6 months.
  - To maximize the duration of the open work permit, make sure your passport is valid for at least 3 years from the date of approval.
- have graduated no more than 5 years before you apply for this open work permit, with:
  - a degree from a <u>designated post-secondary learning institution in</u> <u>Canada</u> or abroad, or
  - a diploma for a minimum 2-year program from a <u>designated post-</u> secondary learning institution in Canada or abroad

#### If you got your diploma abroad

If you got your diploma outside of Canada, you must provide an Educational Credential Assessment (ECA) from an organization or a professional body designated by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada. They'll give you a report that tells you what your education is equal to in Canada.

Processing times and costs vary by organization or professional body.

Once you choose a designated organization or a professional body, they'll tell you how to submit your documents to get your assessment.

#### **Designated organizations**

You must use one of these designated organizations:

- <u>Comparative Education Service University of Toronto School of</u> <u>Continuing Studies</u>
  - designated: April 17, 2013
- International Credential Assessment Service of Canada
  - designated: April 17, 2013
- <u>World Education Services</u>
  - designated: April 17, 2013
- International Qualifications Assessment Service (IQAS)
  - designated: August 6, 2015
- International Credential Evaluation Service
  - designated: August 6, 2015

You must apply for the open work permit online. You can't apply at a port of entry.
